Weigh-ins

Weigh-ins will be on Saturday at the tournament site. Sunday weigh-ins will start at 8:00 am. If you weighed in on Saturday, you must check in on Sunday. Competitors must supply their own white and blue belts unless a white and blue gi is required. **U10/U12 will be required to provide their weight at registration, random sampling will occur on site.**

Note: All participants must come to the official weigh in with their 2023-24 Judo Canada membership card or Judo Ontario Online registration receipt. Foreign competitors must bring a current membership card of their association.

U14 and Up athletes must weigh-in wearing their judo gi pants and a t-shirt no exceptions. No stripping of clothing will be allowed. Allowances are as follows:

U14 600 grams

U16-U21 800 grams

Senior & Veterans 1 kg

Referees

Referees planning to officiate should present themselves to the Chief Referee for role call at 8:30 am on Saturday morning.

Eligibility- Referees must be paid up members of Judo Ontario, or other Provincial/Territorial associations, or IJF recognized Association.

Rules and eligibility

All paid up members of Provincial Associations.

Judo Canada and IJF recognized associations of other countries.

IJF Rules apply Judo Canada and Judo Ontario regulations as of the date will be enforced.

True double elimination

Round robin for 5 or less.

The Tournament Director with the approval of the Chief Official reserves the right to delete, combine, or alter any category or division, if necessary, for the successful running of this tournament.

Any division changes effecting minors must have parent or coach consent of all competitors in NEW/RECEIVING DIVISION.

Any division changes effecting adult competitors must have the written consent of all competitors in the receiving division.

If there are insufficient entries in ne-waza the divisions will be combined within the required weight allowances.

U10/U12 will be required to provide their weight at registration, random sampling will occur on site.

U14/U16 and under must have a white gi, the second individual called has the option of a blue gi.

Participants in this tournament are allowed to compete in a second division taking place on the same day providing that the second division is scheduled in a separate block of the event and at discretion of the tournament director.

Competition Schedule

Saturday – U10/U12 must report in at 8:00 and competition start time is 9:00 am. Weigh in schedule for other divisions will be posted Thursday April 25, 2023

Saturday April 27th – Shiai Weigh-ins commence at 9:30 am schedule to be posted April 25th on Website/Facebook/Instagram

Sunday April 28th – Ne-waza Weigh-ins commence at 8:00 am

Sunday Kata check-in from 8:00 am Start time 9:00 am

We do our best to have accurate division start times but due to unforeseen circumstances all start times are approximate. Athletes must be weighed in and at the tournament site per the weigh-in schedule.

Competitors will attest to their weight upon registration, weight divisions will be determined based on the competitors registered and will comply with the Judo Canada recommendations of a maximum 15% weight difference.

When registering for the kata divisions first select the category of the specific kata in either Intermediate or Senior kata divisions, don't select an age group example: U16, U18, U21, Senior, Veteran....

FEES

Fee: **Senior: \$80 per team/kata**
Intermediate: \$60 per team/kata
Refunds will be provided only if the event is cancelled.

Multiple entries: Multiple entries with different partners are permitted with payment of a separate entry fee. Exception: A pair cannot perform both Senior Nage-No-Kata 3 set and 5 set in the same positions.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

Rules: IJF Rules – Regulations for Kata

Format: All teams will present their kata once in this competition.

Grading exemptions will be available for Senior Nage-No Kata only (3 and 5 sets). If you intend to use your performance for Ontario grading purposes, please indicate this when submitting your registration.

JUDGES

Judges will be selected by the JOKC. A judge cannot also be a competitor in the event. Interested qualified judges (IJF, PJC, & National) should contact Malgorzata Lampman at katacommittee@judoontario.ca no later than **April 21, 2024**.
